


Miulti-Purpose Rosebud Dish or Plain Fluted Dish

Pattern of the Month


Use this dish to hold a special candle, a dried flower arrangement, a favorite shell collection, and much more. It will serve beautifully as a plant saucer if the inside lines are coasted with silicone sealer. Do not however, use the dish for food of any sort.


Instructions:

- 1. Cut glass to make four sides and one base piece. For rosebud dish, cut the inside dotted lines, ignoring the heavy perimeter line where it crosses through them.
- 2. Either dish Tack solder together the four side pieces to form a square. Sides will angle out.
- 3. Set the four joined sides on the worktable and place the base in the center. It will rest on the table. Solder in place inside and out.
- 4. Solder a #20 copper wire around the top edge of the project; bury the wire with solder.
